

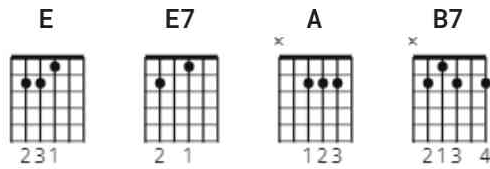

Capo: 1st fret

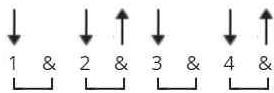
