

For the intro part and the second to last instrumental part you hammer the high ${\sf E}$ string on the first ${\sf D}$ so

it's 0-hammer-2.

Any time the Dm9 is played, there is also a hammer on from the open G string to the 5th fret, in rhythm with the song.
